

Thank you for your patience as we reviewed our current COVID policies. In order to provide a clear guideline for our families, we are adopting the policies recommended by the CDC. Please review the below guidelines when determining whether you need to isolate after exposure or positive testing.

We will be enforcing assigned class spots to provide social distancing and to help identify potential first contacts if needed. As always, the studio is disinfected thoroughly each evening with barres, bathrooms and hot spots cleaning throughout each class and on an hourly basis.

We realize schools may have differing policies, which is why we have chosen to adopt the same policies as the CDC to give you a consistent reference point. Please continue to monitor symptoms and stay home if not feeling well and email us for a Zoom code to participate remotely if your dancer is feeling up to it.

We have unfortunately had some dancers still come to class that have been asked to isolate from an outside exposure. As a business we require all families to follow through with any quarantine or isolation requests from other places (daycares/schools/work/home). We are all on the honor system and hope we can get through 2022 safe and happily dancing.

If you have made the decision to get vaccinated, please bring in your vaccine card and show someone at the front desk to help make our contact tracing more streamlined.

If You Test Positive for COVID-19 (Isolate) **Everyone, regardless of vaccination status.**

- Stay home for 5 days.
- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house.
- Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.

If you have a fever or symptoms, continue to stay home until you symptoms resolve.

If You Were Exposed to Someone with COVID-19 (Quarantine)

If you:

Have been boosted

OR

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months

OR

Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5, if possible.

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home until you receive a negative result. No at home test results will be accepted, only certified results of a rapid or PCR test.

If you:

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted

OR

Completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and are not boosted

OR

Are unvaccinated

- Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
- If you can't quarantine you must wear a mask for 10 days.
- Test on day 5 if possible.

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home until you receive a negative result. No at home test results will be accepted, only certified results of a rapid or PCR test.
